### Anglian Water:

Anglian Water is a partner in a world-first project to build low carbon greenhouses. The greenhouses will be the largest in the UK and will be warmed by the waste heat from its own treatment facilities. When built, the greenhouses are expected to produce 12 per cent of the UK's tomato supply, while reducing the carbon footprint of the produce by 75 per cent – a win both for the region's economy and the environment.
